The **Virginia Family Violence & Sexual Assault Hotline** receives more than 40,000 calls annually and connects people to support in their communities.

Technical assistance and certification standards **help Sexual and Domestic Violence Agencies** ensure services to victims of sexual and domestic violence are of high quality.

The Action Alliance works to **improve access to services and safety for all people**. This includes people of color; lesbian/gay/bi/trans communities; Latinos; people who are deaf; people in later life, teens and children; people with disabilities; people with mental illnesses; men; people of faith; victims who are incarcerated or criminally charged, and others.

The **Training Institute** trains over 1,000 professionals every year who work in sexual and domestic violence agencies and allied fields throughout Virginia.

Our **legislative initiatives** secure funding for community based Sexual and Domestic Violence Agencies, strengthen enforcement of current laws, and promote an effective response to sexual and domestic violence.

We manage **VAdata: The Virginia Sexual & Domestic Violence Data Collection System**. VAdata protects confidentiality and meets local, state, and federal data needs for Virginia's Sexual & Domestic Violence Agencies.
